

Arab Postal Day Joint Issue 2012

Historical Background :

Issuing a Joint stamp for Arab Postal Day is every three years on the occasion of «Arab Post Day». This is a decision of the « Permanent Arab Committee » For the 22 States members in the Arab League . The first issue was released in 2008 . The supposed version stamp was planned to be issued in 2011, and because of the events experienced by the region it is postponed to year later .

Design selection is opened for all member states . Final design is selected between Syrian , Saudi Arabia , Sudan , Oman , Qatar and Egypt Post .The Communications Ministers decided to include the design of Syrian due to freeze Syria's membership in the Arab League, and it has led to the formation of a working group, chaired by Qatar, and the membership of Tunisia, Saudi Arabia, Iraq, Egypt, and the Technical Secretariat to evaluate the proposals for the design of the Arab Postal Day. The design chosen was the Omani with the following amendments in the design . Such as Framework blue and red inside the character .
