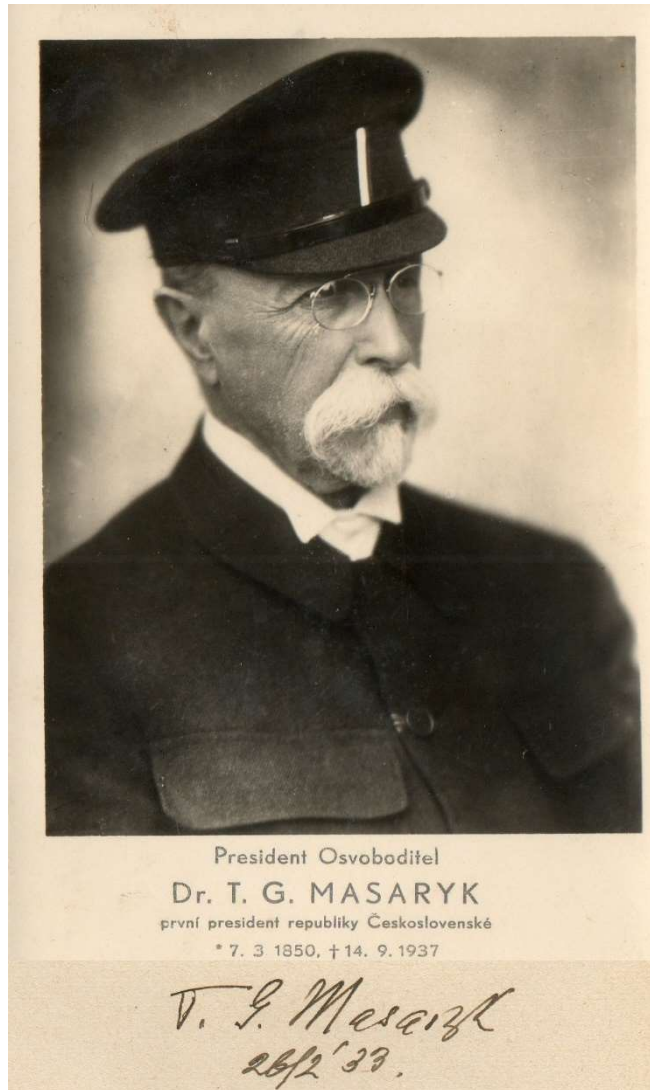

4. 1925 - 75th birthday of T.G. Masaryk (engraving)

Finally, I would like to highlight one of my own discoveries. It is a cover no. 16 paid by a 1 CZK stamp, catalogue no. pofis 194. This letter has a postmark dated by July 27th 1925. However, catalogues and literature state that this stamp was not put into postal usage until August 1925.
