## Report of the Jury of Liberec 2022

The jury of Liberec 2022 has completed judging and is pleased to present this report.

The jury has judged a total of 198 exhibits and 49 literature exhibits. The jury members have found that the quality of exhibits shown has been of a very high standard. We have awarded 11 Large Gold Medals and 40 Gold Medals. We are pleased to see that many exhibits have made significant improvements since they were shown in previous exhibitions.

5 exhibits were transferred to a different exhibition class to ensure they achieved a better award. Unfortunately, 6 exhibits did not arrive and 1 was out of competition, so a total of 7 exhibits could not be judged.

The jury would like to thank the Liberec 2022 Organising Committee and especially its President Jiří Kraus and all volunteers, the FIP Liaison officer and National commissioners for their efficiency and hard work. We are grateful for all exhibitors who have brought their exhibits, either themselves or through their National commissioners, since their presence in Liberec made the visitors appreciate our wonderful hobby.


Finally, we would like to thank the Liberec 2022 exhibition organisers also for their warm hospitality, the fine facilities and support provided for the jury.

## REPORT OF THE EXPERT GROUP

The Expert Group of Liberec 2022 inspected all exhibits in each competitive class. Dubious items reported by judging teams were checked. In addition, all the exhibits best in Class awarded exhibits were carefully examined.

The Expert Group made a specific review of exhibits which had been queried at previous FIP exhibitions (including FIAP/FEPA/FIAF) where certificates were requested. Out of 17 items identified, 7 had a certificate provided and 10 items were not exhibited. One description was changed according to FIP rule.

As a result, a total of 20 items were examined closer and the recommendations of the Expert Group were as follow:

The reports of the items examined together with illustrations will be handed over to the respective exhibitors through the national commissioners. Copies of all reports will be handed over to FIP for follow up at later exhibitions.
